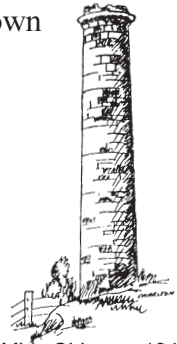


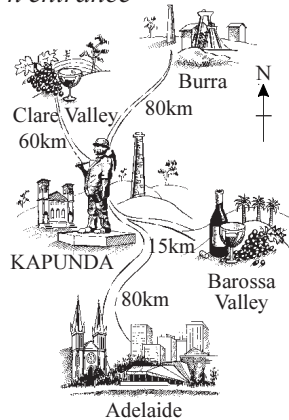
- View the latest traveling exhibition or fine local art works by renowned artists at one of **Kapunda's numerous art spaces**

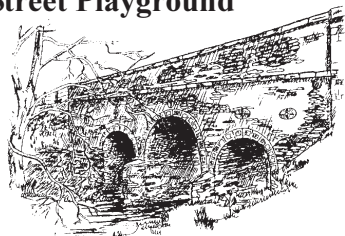
